A rare solid sterling silver quaich cup or bowl. It is hallmarked for London 1898 with the makers marks being that of Searle & Co (Walter Henry Searle), it is also marked to the base. It has been superbly made being embossed with the Worshipful Company of Grocers (an ancient Livery Company) crest along with their motto 'GOD GRANT GRACE'. It is in superb condition, having no dings splits or repairs. It measures approx. 5.25 inches (13.3cms) across including the handles and 3.75 inches (9.7cms) excluding them by 2 inches (5.1cms) tall to the top of the handles and it weighs 104 grams. A stunning example.
