Description

A rare and charming rug of the Baluch nomads of Khorassan Province, north-east Persia and made around 1870-1880. The natural camel-hair field contains a myriad of stylised creatures - peacocks, deer, gazelle and even a little chicken at the very top left. The outer and inner borders contain seated camels and the main border, stylised peacocks - symbols of immortality and wealth. Note the ivory date inserted into the main border lower middle left. The rug, which is in excellent condition, is complete with goat-hair selvages and ivory elems. Size: 1.53 x 0.91m (5' 0" x 3' 0").
