The underside is where the makers mark G & S EP London for the silversmith, GEORGE GOODFELLOW & SONS of London, EP meaning Electro-Plated. The lid has a wonderful Ivory button knob to the front to open the lid. The tray within is where the butter would sit with ice beneath to keep it nice and cool.
