Early C19th French Charles X Restauration period mahogany console table fitted with original marble top. Stylish figured mahogany rectangular console table of Empire design, fitted with a single full-length oak-lined 'concealed' frieze drawer and carrying the original highly-striated 'Gris St.Anne' grey-and-white marble top . Raised on scroll-type supports with architectural carved lateral corbels , carved 'sun-burst' type terminals onto 'zoomorphic' carved claw feet . The central base platform of serpentine bow-shaped outline. The marble top with a double reed moulded-edge profile. In excellent original condition with a rich colour and patina to the well-selected flame mahogany veneers . Of good practical scale and elegant proportions , ideal for use in a hall-way as a console or perhaps in a drawing room as a drinks table . Distinctive and prized 'Gris St.Anne' marble is mainly quarried in Belgium at Gougnies near Charleroi .and Biesme, Namur. H 36" W 50" D 19" France c.1830
