Stamped by the manufacturer to the underside. Pieces from this cabinet maker don't come onto the market very often. Wonderful proportions with good height. Very well carved legs and extremely heavy and sturdy. The stool has just been re-upholstered by ourselves in a fabulous material with a slight Chinoiserie influence.
