He studied under William Bromley and also with Bonnat and Cormon in Paris. Yeend King was typical of many late Victorian painters of rustic genre, often painting garden scenes with pretty girls. However, his robust 'plein air' technique and bold palette were obviously the influence of his Paris training. He married the sister of Robert Gallon's wife. He exhibited widely between 1874 and 1924, including the Royal Academy, Suffolk Street, New Watercolour Society, Grosvenor Gallery, as well as in the provinces. He was elect...
