A set of 3 early Georgian period dining chairs, in the country vernacular Chippendale style, Circa C1760. Elm frames with peg jointed construction, pleasingly figured throughout. The backs with serpentine top rails, over pierced variform slats, solid paneled seats, with sculpted front apron rail, raised on square legs with supporting stretcher all round. A charming set of good original period chairs, full of character with attractive aged wear and patina. Ready for use. Dimensions: These chairs measure approximately 94 cm (37") tall, 46 cm (18") wide, and 44 cm (17.5") deep. The seat height measures approximately 44.5 cm (17.5"). Condition: Please see the pictures for details of the items condition. - These chairs are in a good original condition, commensurate with their age, and are structurally sound and sturdy. There are several marks, blemishes and signs of use. No obvious signs of repair. Natural aged separation between the planks in the seats. One splat has an aged natural split though the middle section, but it does not affect it structurally. Good colour, polish and patina. No loose joints.
