This one is modelled as a jockey's cap, with three distinct coloured sections of cushion separated by silver 'ribbons'. It is hallmarked for Birmingham 1895, with the maker's mark for Cornelius Desormeaux Saunders & James Francis Hollings (Frank) Shepherd. The original cushions, possibly cork, have faded and are flaking away in places. Nonetheless, a relatively rare collector's item. Dimensions: Length: 6cm Width: 4.5cm Height: 2.5cm.
