Rests upon a double series opaque twist stem consisting of a pair of corkscrews outside a pair of spiral tapes. Conical foot with a snapped pontil. **Date & Origin** England, c1760. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, no chips cracks or restoration **Dimensions** Height: 13.8cm Rim diameter: 4.5cm Foot diameter: 6.8cm **Historical Relevance** March 20th, 1760, the 'Great' Fire of Boston destroyed 349 buildings and the 'Great' Comet named C/1760 A1 approached Earth within 0.0682 AUs.

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
