The base of the tumbler has a hollow compartment containing two dice. Polished pontil. **Date & Origin** Bohemia, c1870. **Condition** The base has a thin manufacturing internal annealing crack which does not come to the surface. The tumble can be used as normal. **Dimensions** Height: 9.8cm Diameter: 8.7cm. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time The Married Women's Property Act 1870 allowed married women to be the legal owners of the money they earned and to inherit property.
