Description

Technical Description A fantastic set of three amethyst glass serving bottles dating to around 1830. Copper/white metal and cork stoppers. Very unusual string rims and large polished pontils. **Comments** Holding approx 1 full modern bottle of wine each, these make superb serving bottles / decanters for the larger dinner party, or simply as a decorative set for the kitchen window. Sets of three are exceptionally rare and it's been four years since we last had a pair. **Date & Origin** England, c1830. Period of Victoria. **Condition** Excellent, no chips cracks, or restoration. Two of the stoppers have parts of the cork missing (see pictures), however, serving bottles from this period, as a general rule, didn't have stoppers, so they are additions from the same period...and we think they look very elegant. No major scratches and clean and clear internally. **Dimensions** Height: 31cm Diameter: 8.5cm. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown approx 30 years before Abraham Lincoln was elected the 16th American President.
