The stem is comprised of a pair of spiral threads outside a gauze. The conical foot has a rough pontil. **Date & Origin** England, c1760. Period of George III. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 19.7cm Bowl Diameter: 6.4cm Foot diameter: 7.3cm. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time of "The Treaty of Hubertusburg", which put an end to the Seven Years' War between Prussia and Austria.
