Description

A fine Regency period sofa table of unusually small proportions; the shallow top with deep leaves, veneered with finely matched and richly coloured kingwood veneers, cross-banded in rosewood and inlaid with decorative arabesque scrollwork panels; the frieze fitted with two 'concealed' drawers, similarly inlaid, and mounted on a square central column with hipped and splayed legs with brass claw castors. Circa 1820 John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940. We are a traditional antiques shop, but very much in the 21st century. We deal in 18th and early 19th century furniture, barometers and clocks. We choose our stock for its originality and for the quality of its colour, patination and design. We are members of the BADA.
