This pretty 19th century ring decorated with rose-cut marcasites is full of glitter and sparkle. The marcasites are set above a ground of royal blue enamel on a solid silver shank encased in rose gold. The outside of the shank is stamped with the boar's head hallmark which indicates French silver of minimum 800 fineness. The ring is in good antique condition. There is some wear to the rose gold shank, showing the silver beneath. Under magnification you can see some of the marcasites are cracked but this does not diminish their sparkle and is not evident to the naked eye. Size: P (UK), approx 7.75 (US).
