Description

Antique silver half hunter pocket watch, HMS Impregnable. The watch has a Swiss 17-jewel stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover which has an inscription, 'P J Desborough, 22nd Dec 1909, HMS Impregnable'. HMS Impregnable was a training ship situated in Devonport. She was launched in 1810 and converted to a training ship in 1862 (photo attached of HMS Impregnable in 1910... the photo was taken from the internet and is not included in the sale). The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the three covers for Birmingham 1909, with a case maker's mark for Aaron Dennison. Dennisons was a Birmingham based watch case manufacturer who supplied most of the cases for Waltham UK. The case is in good condition and the front cover has a small central lens which is surrounded by dark blue enamel filled Roman numerals. The winding crown pushes in to open the front cover. Inside, there is an acrylic lens which is in good condition. The signed dial is in good condition with original blued steel hands (including the special half hunter hour ...
