The glass has a conical bowl and sits on a double ball knob. The plain and wide foot is slightly domed and has the expected broken pontil mark. With today's fashion for flavoured Gins that are often drunk with out mixers, this is the perfect capacity. A charming example of good collector's piece, with a practical use 230 years on.
