Description

A fine pair of 3 branch candelabra made of Old Sheffield Plate and dating to c1830-1840. All parts bear a crest, a cockerel to the base and a partridge (or similar) to the branch section. There are no makers marks. One candlestick has a later applied plaque to the base, inscribed for 'Presented to Dr H Gordon Smith by the Staff of the Public Health Dept on his Retirement as M.O.H. Bournemouth Feb 1950'. Each candlestick has a removable branch section, a removable central holder and removable sconces. The condition is good overall, but both candlesticks have a certain degree of copper bleed to the raised edges, and are slightly crooked to the branches, as is to be expected due to age and use. Both have green braise to the bases. Total weight approx 4.8kg. Total height approx 50cm Span approx 42cm. Base diameter approx 14cm.

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
