Recently fresh to the market from a deceased farm estate in Shropshire. A case that has been shielded from the light and has probably been in the same family since it was first commissioned by Spicers. Circa 1904 -1920. This fine female Black Grouse sometimes referred by country folk as a 'Grey Hen' is magnificently modelled against a remarkable painted back drop within a ebonized case with gilt quadrant beading to the front (this was the firms most expensive model) and is all in beautiful condition.
