The interior having an arrangement of four oak lined drawers and pigeon holes. The two oak lined drawers below with over lip mouldings and original brass open plate handles and the sides with similar brass carrying handles. The bureau sits on its original mahogany stand, having a moulded edge to the frame raised on square legs with an inner chamfer joined by traditional 'H' stretchers.
