Of serpentine form and made from the highest grade of solid mahogany with attractive mahogany veneers. Decorated with inlaid foliate detailing throughout. The glazed top section has a single door (lockable, key supplied) which opens to access a lined and shelved interior. This is surmounted by a cornice of broken-arch swan neck form. The base is also of serpentine fronted form and has a single drawer fitted with its original solid brass handles. All standing on long, elegant out swept legs, united by an under-tier. Sympathetically repolished and re-lined in our workshops. Now offered for sale in excellent condition, with a great colour and patina, ready to go straight into the home. Splits into 3 sections for ease of installation. Dimensions: Width 78cms Depth 38cms Height 194cms Edwards & Roberts was founded in 1845, and had premises at 21 Wardour Street London.
