Description

A very pretty Edwardian pendant in richly coloured 15-carat gold studded with tiny gleaming seed pearls. The design depicts a swallow in flight with a sprig of ivy in its beak - in Victorian England (immediately preceding the Edwardians) a flying swallow was traditionally considered a token of good luck and the bird represented enduring love and loyalty, as the swallow mates for life. Ivy also symbolised longlasting love, whether that of a deep friendship or a marriage. The pendant is in excellent antique condition. Marked 15 on the reverse. Fifteen-carat gold pieces are not overly common (in the UK only really used between 1854 and 1932) and as this fineness was generally used in high quality pieces, it is attractive to collectors.
