The domed cover with ball finial and matching bright-cut decorations. The back with a reeded scroll handle. The shell thumb piece opening to reveal an interior fitted with a blue glass liner. Sold with a Georgian silver condiment spoon engraved with the letter "H" and bearing the marks of William Eaton, London 1824. Hallmarks: C.F for Crispin Fuller. Duty Mark.
