It is made of exquisite ormolu (finely gilded bronze) mounted with delicately painted Sèvres style porcelain with a blue ground. The panel below the dial is exquisitely painted with a scene of two finely dressed young ladies in a country setting with garlands of roses. The panels to the front and sides, and the urn to the top are delicately painted with flowers. Porcelain is faintly signed to the reverse. The dial porcelain enamel on copper with blue and black lettering. It is complete with its original finely cut gilt hands and is signed for the clockmaker Raingo Frères. The rear bezel is glazed to allow the movement to be seen. The early French movement is of high quality and has a silk suspension. It is by Raingo Frères and has been fully overhauled and tested by our clockmaker. Pendulum is original. It runs for 8 days and strikes the hours and halves on a bell. We have a video of the clock running, please ask and we will send you a link. Condition of the case is excellent, the original gilding is beautifully...
