Early C19th Regency period mahogany 4-door 'dwarf' bookcase cabinet of breakfront outline. Fine quality mahogany breakfront bookcase with 4 glazed doors, the interior fitted with original adjustable 'ladder-racking' mahogany shelves with scribed or moulded front edges. The doors fitted with original brass hinges and locks and working key, mounted with architectural turned column support uprights with block bases and turned capitals. The whole raised on a conforming breakfront-outline plinth base. The highly-figured mahogany top with minor historic shrinkage 'creases' to the twin mahogany board construction at each end. Retains the original polished surface which has achieved a rich, consistent colour and patina. A stylish and well-proportioned bookcase of restrained design, providing excellent practical storage for books and objects. H 38" W 60" D 16" (centre) England c.1820
