A rare silver mounted table vesta, dating from the mid-Victorian era. This handsome example has a superb cut glass rectangular body, with strawberry diamonds and a multi-point star to the base. The hallmarked silver lid is beautifully engraved with acanthus scrolls, geometric patterns and a central cartouche with original script initials. The lid is hinged and opens to reveal a second inner lid, also hinged, which is the striker. This in turn opens to reveal the glass reservoir for holding the matches. A desirable and collectable item of Victorian silver. Dimensions below.
