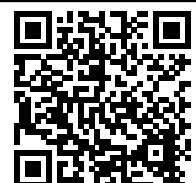
Technical Description A fine 18th-century Light Baluster dating to c1745. It has a large round funnel bowl with Rococo engravings which includes fine garlands of flowers and cherubs heads. Sits on a complex multi-knop stem consisting of a triple annulated shoulder knob above a slender inverted baluster and basal knob. Conical foot with a snapped pontil. **Date & Origin** England or Holland, c1745. Period of George II. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration. **Dimensions** Height: 18.7cm Rim diameter: 8.2cm Foot diameter: 7.5cm. **Historical Relevance** Prussia and Austria sign the Treaty of Dresden giving much of Silesia to the Prussians. Also, Charles Edward Stuart, "the Young Pretender", lands at Eriskay Island in the Hebrides

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
