Further stiff-leaf' gilded ormolu mounts to the base of the marble bodies . The cream coloured marble having attractive grey and peach coloured striating and veining . Smart quality pair of Louis XVI style marble vases of neat scale and proportions, being of an ideal size for a mantelpiece or side cabinet. In excellent original condition with no damage or repairs.
