The stem with a circular knop. The capitals with the original detachable sconces. There are Full hallmarks struck to the side of each base and partial hallmarks struck to the sleeve of each capital. The date letters differ by a year on the candlesticks which happened quite often in retailing but they are a genuine pair. A fine pair of candlesticks. Hallmarks: WH&S LD for William Hutton & Sons.
