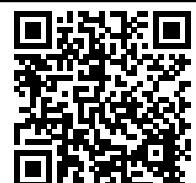
Description

We are delighted to offer this large Imperial Russian silver cloisonne enamel spoon likely by either Vasili Akimov/Vasili Andreyev. The spoon's overall proportions are substantial and impressive in hand. Decorated from the tip to the handle, the cloisonne enamelwork is finely crafted and aesthetically very pleasing. The reverse side of the spoon features a typical late 19th Century Russian enamel design with exquisite floral, foliate and scrolled motifs. The handle is equally embellished with a rich array of colours with a 'twisted' neck section connecting the two. The rest of the spoon is fully gilt with a beautiful gold tone. The spoon is hallmarked on the side of the twisted stem with the maker's mark 'BA' and the combined standard and city mark signifying the Moscow region as well as the 84 zolotnik silver standard. A wonderful collectable piece of fine Imperial Russian silverware ideal for enamel lovers.
