It is in very good condition with some expert re-piling, mainly in parts of the outer border and selvedge area. The camel field contains a myriad of octagonal '8-pointed stars' and the main ivory border, containing 'X' symbols. Size: 1.55m x 0.81m (5' 1" x 2' 8").
