An interesting pair of George II lead tobacco boxes, Circa 1750. One has a dog handle and relief decoration of gentleman of the period smoking together. The other has relief around the edges depicting foliage and the handle depicts a man's head. One of the boxes has an interior lead piece with knob for tamping down the tobacco. Both pieces have signs of wear commensurate with their age. Being made of lead they collectively weigh 2.750 kgs.
