## Description

A quality English solid sterling silver mounted noggin jug. It is hallmarked for Sheffield 1904 with the makers marks being that of Lee & Wigfull (Henry Wigfull). It has been beautifully made having a glass base and a sterling silver mounted spout and lid. It was used to hold a small amount of whisky or brandy on a bedside of fireside table rather than use the large decanter. This example is a more unusual shape. It is in superb condition with the silver being free from splits repairs and dings. The glass is free from cracks chips and repairs. It measures approx. 3 inches (7.6cms) tall to the lid by 2.75 inches (5.6cms) spout to handle by approx. 1.75 inches (4.5cms) wide and weighs 66 grams. A beautiful usable piece.
