Description

Good example of a high quality antique microscope dating from the late 19th Century. The microscope parts are made of lacquered brass and it sits on heavy horse shoe shaped base. The whole microscope tilts, the eyepiece tube is extendable and has a rack and pinion coarse focus as well as an additional fine focus knob at the rear. It has a square shaped stage with two slide clips. Below the stage is a large adjustable mirror for focusing the light source towards the microscope and a revolving pinwheel. The microscope is stamped on the back of the base with the retailer's name "R.G.Mason. Optician, Clapham, S.W." The microscope comes with one eyepiece lens and two objective lenses, believed to be original. The lenses come in their original brass cases marked "Wray, London 1/4in" and "Wray, London 1in". It also comes with a live box, an adjustable pair of tweezers for holding specimens and an additional large lens. The microscope comes in a fitted wooden box with sections to hold the lenses and accessories. The box has a good quality brass carrying handle and a metal closing latch. It is a strong sturdy box with a nice patina. The box measures approximately 12" tall x 8" ...
