The other panels with flowering wisteria, cherry blossom, bamboo, and peony. The shoulder painted with a continuous band of Ruyi head, containing stylised flowerheads, beneath a gilt chevron motif to the neck. Signed Setsuzan in gilt, beneath a blue Satsuma Mon, to the base.
