Description

A good and beautifully painted historic record of an early Steam Wood Gunvessel "HMS Jaseur", built in 1862 lying moored up in either the River Dart, or River Fal, painted in oils on canvas by Henry John MORGAN (1839-1917). Good detail, recording much of the rigging in particular. Framed in a good slip frame within an ornate gilt outer frame. Henry J Morgan (1839-1917) was a known painter of warships and naval engagements, often in port, but sometimes in action. Signed to the lower right corner. Dimension: Visible canvas: 16ins x 12ins (41 x 30.5cm). Frame: 23.75ins x 19.5ins (60 x 49.5cm). Condition: Frame and canvas in excellent condition. Colour is bright with no sign of any cracking. Dated: c.1868-70.
