Description

This substantial Victorian ring is an absolute stunner! A sparkling halo of old-cut white diamonds surrounds a large natural split pearl, set into a decorative silver setting and mounted on a richly coloured 18-carat gold shank. The diamonds are hand cut, in the old style with a small high table; as each one is unique and differently shaped it is difficult to calculate their exact weight - at around 3mm diameter, if they were modern brilliant cuts they would total more than a carat and they certainly pack a punch in the sparkle department! Hallmarked for 18-carat gold, London 1898 (rubbed). The ring is in very good antique condition; the engraving along the shoulders is a little worn, in keeping with the age of the piece. The stones are crisply faceted and the pearl has a lovely glowing nacre. Size: P (UK), approximately 8 (US). The stone-set face of the ring measures approx 1.5cm across and it sits around 1cm above the finger. The pearl is 7mm diameter. Weight: 4.6g. FREE INTERNATIONAL SHIPPING!
