Victorian wheel barometer in a mahogany 'onion top' case, by W.E. Pain of Cambridge with an 8" silvered register, an hygrometer, a thermometer and a spirit level. Circa 1850 W. E. Pain was established in 1827 until the early 2000s. Pain was an associate of the Cambridge Philosophical Society. The firm's final address was at 21 King's Parade. The Pain family would have retailed this instrument in one of their chemist shops in Cambridge.
