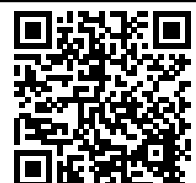
Description

It is beautifully fretted and engraved with flowers and a foliate lattice design which incorporates a shield on one side for monogramming or presentation. It has a decoratively fretted hinged handle for lifting and its original Bristol blue glass liner which fits snugly into the basket and is supported by four shaped brackets which are attached to in inside of each foot.
