Description

This truly tribal flat-weave or 'jajim' might have been used to cover and decorate the camel's load whilst on migration and then subsequently used on the floor of the tent or to cover the bedding around the circumference. I haven't come across a weaving of this type before and my thoughts regarding attribution point to Qashqa'i work. It is strong and extremely well made and would look stunning on a wooden floor in a modern home. All the dyes are natural and it is complete with braided ends and tassels. Woven circa 1900, it is in excellent condition. Size: 2.13m x 1.52m (7' x 5').
