Turned columns attached to the hood door, capped with brass capitals. Long trunk door with razor edge moulding, fixed with original strap hinges. Box base, with shaped plinth. Arched brass dial with silvered and engraved name boss to the arch, Silvered chapter ring, seconds zone and ringed calendar. Finely cast gilded urn spandrels to the corners and dolphin spandrels to the arch. Extremely well executed matting to the dial centre. Finely quality original blued steel hands. Excellent quality fully restored 5 pillar 8 day movement, striking the hours on a single bell. Matching original lead weights and brass faced pendulum bob. William Mayhew.
