The 4" circular silvered brass dial with Roman chapter ring, signed to the dial centre Barraud and Lund Cornhill, 2053. The fine quality twin fusee, 8 day, movement signed and numbered to the rear, the same as the dial. Original anchor escapement, striking the hours and half hour on a curled gong, with pull repeat and strike/strike silent facility. Beautiful blued steel hands. Original brass winding key, numbered 2053. The finely carved mahogany case with 4 turned and carved finials and carved egg and dart mouldings. Intricate sound frets to the case sides and bevelled glass to the case front. Barraud & Lund 1838 - 1929; 41 Cornhill, London, successors to the family firm Barraud & Sons. Manufacturers of high quality watches and clocks; invented the electric system of synchronising public clocks.
