Fine quality 8 day movement, striking the hours on a single bell. Blued steel hands. Andrew McMillan apprenticed to Francis Reid, clock and watchmaker in Glasgow and freeman of the Incorporation of Hammerman on 25th August 1837. A watchmaker and jeweller at 5 Argyle Arcade in 1837 - 1855, then at Nos 6 & 7 in 1860 - 1865. A rare and unusual Scottish clock, in superb original condition.
