Polished pontil. We are all familiar with Bristol blue wine glasses and decanters, however, finding a 19th-century water jug is a rare occurrence and we have only had one in the last 3 years. **Date & Origin** England, c1880. Period of Victoria. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. No chips cracks or restoration **Dimensions** Height: 14cm DiameterBowl : 8.6cm **Historical Relevance** Handcrafted around the time the Natural History Museum was opened in London on the 18th of April 1881.
