The layout and antique aesthetics of the original box make for an excellent display piece whether in a collection or on a fine table as part of interior decor. Each spoon features a classic Russian twist-design handle and an engraved bowl. Though the gilding has worn over the years, the parcel gilt bowls of the spoons are still apparent and present a lovely contrast between the gold and silver tone. Each spoon is fully hallmarked on the side of the stem.
