One features figures in a snow covered village square near a church. The other depicts a group of children near a village green having a snowball fight. George Augustus Williams was born on 4 May, 1814 in Marylebone, London into the Williams family of artists. His father was Edward Williams (1781-1855) a landscape painter and patriarch of the Barnes School of artists and his mother was Ann Hildebrandt. He was one of 6 sons who all became artists: Edward Charles Williams (1807-1881), Henry John Boddington (1811-1865), Arthur Gilbert (1819-1895), Sidney Richard Percy (1821-1886) and Alfred Walter Williams (1824-1905). Williams and all of his brothers were tutored by their father. He married Caroline Francis Smith on 19 February, 1835 and one of their sons Walter Williams (1834-1906) also became an artist. He initially lived in Liverpool Street, Grays Inn Road...
