Description

This chunky half saddle-bag, with its superb array of natural dyes, was made by Jaf Kurds in Kurdistan, during the second half of the nineteenth century. The bag retains its plain-weave back in narrow horizontal bands of colour, albeit with the loss of the top part of the back. Nevertheless, this is a great example of the bags made by the Jaf tribe in the nineteenth century. Size: 76cm x 64cm (2' 6" x 2' 1").
