These diminutive and very collectable pieces would have been for a table snuff box and most were Assayed In London. Unusually these bear only the Maker's mark for Dorothy Langlands and would have originated in Newcastle. Wonderful and desirable pieces of English Provincial silver, with the added benefit of being by a female Newcastle silversmith. Dimensions below.
