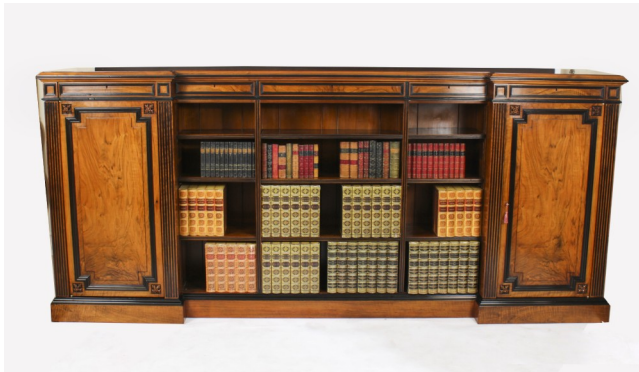

This is a beautiful antique William IV figured walnut and ebonised low breakfront bookcase, circa 1835 in date. It has a shaped top with five frieze drawers above a central open bookcase with three adjustable shelves all between fluted columns. With a pair of cupboards to each side that feature figured walnut panel doors decorated with ebonised mouldings and carved rosettes at the corners. The cabinet is raised on a decorative plinth base. Complete with original working locks, stamped J Harley & Co, and keys. Condition: In excellent condition having been beautifully cleaned, polished and waxed in our workshops, please see photos for confirmation. Dimensions in cm: Height 124 x Width 278 x Depth 50 Dimensions in inches: Height 4 feet, 1 inch x Width 9 feet, 1 inch x Depth 1 foot, 8 inches William IV - the brief reign of William IV (1830 – 1837) marked a period of transition between the Regency period (which had been an age of innovation based on revivalist styles such as ancient Egypt, and the Grecian designs) and the Victorian era. William IV furniture is similar in style to Regency furniture with many of the designs from the Regency period being copied but...
