Watkins made many different kinds of barometer, including 'Angle Barometers'. This particular barometer has very fine mahogany and generous satinwood edging. The concave brass bezel containing a fabulous silvered brass dial and very flamboyant engraved scroll work around 'change' and a very prominent scroll signed WATKINS, CHARING CROSS, LONDON.
