The etched labels with interesting Latin inscriptions. "Tinct" meaning tincture. One labelled "Hamamelis" which is the latin for Witch Hazel. One labelled "Jalapæ" for Jalap, a Mexican tuber, now obsolete in Western medicine. The necks with the original red litho painted tole lids, showing signs of age with wear to the paint and oxidation.
